PUBLIC NOTICE OF A CASUAL VACANCY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a casual vacancy has occurred in the office of Councillor for St Dominic Parish Council. The Parish Council is therefore seeking applications from eligible members of the community who wish to be considered for this voluntary role.

To be eligible for the role of Parish Councillor, you must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- You are and will continue to be registered as an elector for St Dominic.
- You have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the St Dominic area during the 12 months before the date of this notice.
- Your principal or only place of work during the 12 months before the date of this notice has been in St Dominic.
- You have lived in the parish or within three miles (4.8 kilometres) of the parish boundary during the 12 months before the date of this notice.

Interested individuals should apply in writing to the Clerk. Applications should include:

- A brief outline of why you are interested in being a Parish Councillor.
- Details of the experience and skills you can bring to the Council e.g., professional qualifications, community involvement, business experience.
- Confirmation that you meet the eligibility criteria.

Deadline for applications: 5:00PM on Monday 23 February 2026.

Candidates will be invited to attend a Council meeting on Wednesday 4 March 2026 at St Dominic Parish Hall to say a few words and answer questions before the Council votes on the appointment.
